Remote learning edition



What you will need:

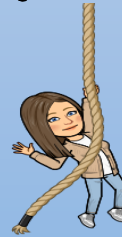
- Dice




	<p>If a black rim comes up to your work, you can open in Google Docs/slides or Kami. Google Docs will open a document which you can type or insert pictures into; Kami will open a document that you can draw onto. See guidance on how to use these on our school website.</p>
	<p>Save your document or Kami in a known file on your device then go onto the +add or create button to find your document and add (more guidance on our website). Then turn in.</p>
