



Remote Learning Offer- Information for Parents and Carers.

All activities will be uploaded via your child's Google Classroom. If you are unable to access these resources, printed packs will be available for collection every Monday between 1pm and 3pm by contacting the school office. Feedback Friday has been established where parents can drop the completed packs back to school so they can be marked by a teacher. These 'marked' packs can then be collected along with the new pack the following week allowing children to respond to the teacher's feedback. Verbal feedback can also be given over the phone if required.

Resources are available at school to support the Remote Learning Offer. This includes exercise books and stationary for your children to work with.

Our core offer, outlined below, will be supplemented by the class teacher to meet the needs of the children within the classes. It is based on the Government guidance of 3 hours remote learning for Key Stage 1 and 4 hours for Key Stage 2.

All work will be uploaded by 9:00am every day and children should access their Google Classroom account to see their daily activities. Children should access Google meet by 9:30am to undertake the class register and check-in with their teachers and friends. Here the teachers will outline the learning for the day.

Why Google Classroom?

Google Classroom is a web-based program that works on a wide variety of devices, including smart phones, Chromebooks, ipads/tablets and even games consoles connected to the internet.

Work will be uploaded using editable Google documents that should be 'Turned in' when completed. Teachers will then be able to comment and give feedback on work that has been 'turned in'. In addition, are able to add attachments and upload photos and videos to these documents to show what your children have been learning.

Foundation Stage

As a Foundation Stage Unit, we will offer a range of activities to support your children achievement across the curriculum. At times, the activities will be for all of the children across the Foundation Unit; other activities will be specifically for children in FS1 or FS2. The current system of using Tapestry will remain in place, alongside Google Classroom, to allow parents/teachers to communicate and upload any observations.

Key Stage 1

In Key Stage 1, we will offer the following range of activities for your child. The activities will be uploaded for your child daily and weekly as specified below. Some activities will also have live lessons to support your child in their learning, others will have clear instructions to help you and your child complete the activities.

Maths	Daily live lesson/pre-recorded lesson with follow up activity Daily arithmetic questions and access to Rockstar maths to support basic skills
English	Daily pre-recorded lesson with follow up activity
Reading	RWI as explained above. Reading for enjoyment promoted through uploaded videos of teacher's reading a variety of stories, as well as access to a virtual library on Google Classroom
RE	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
Science	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
Wellbeing	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
Wider Curriculum	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term

Key Stage 2

In Key Stage 2, we will offer the following range of activities for your child. The activities will be uploaded for your child daily and weekly as specified below. Some activities will also have live lessons, or links to pre-recorded lessons to support your child with their learning.

Phonics	If children are still accessing RWI provision when in school, a daily phonics video will be uploaded to their Google Classroom
Maths	Daily live lesson/pre-recorded lesson with follow up activity Daily arithmetic questions and access to Rockstar maths to support basic skills
English	Daily pre-recorded lesson with follow up activity
Reading	Daily pre-recorded lesson with follow up activity
RE	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
Science	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
Wellbeing	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
Wider Curriculum	Project launch and variety of open-ended activities uploaded to Google Classroom for completion over the half-term
